What is it like at Congregation Shir Hadash for the High Holy Days?

Our liturgy balances Hebrew and English, traditional prayers and creative interpretation. We incorporate individual reflections and guided discussion to make the experience more personal. Transliteration of the liturgy and additional readings are compiled in a booklet to enhance understanding and ease of participation.

Do you have a shofar? Everyone who wishes to is encouraged to blow shofar from their seats when the time comes.

Tickets & Location

Our services are open to all, no tickets required. We do request a donation from guests as financial support is critical to sustaining our congregation.

Please enter our space at Plymouth Church through the courtyard entrance on East Hampshire Street. Synagogue members will greet you, offer you a name tag, and help you feel at home in our community.

The Music

Our wonderful member musicians help shape our sacred space with their voices and instruments. We balance traditional tunes with new settings of prayers by contemporary artists. Everyone is encouraged to sing, dance, or pick up an instrument to help us create a *shir hadash* (a new song).

For Families with Children

We value all our children! They are welcome to be in the prayer space and to come and go as they wish. We have a children's playroom near the prayer space and access to outdoor space as well. Please understand that parents are responsible for helping their children behave appropriately.

Fragrance-Free Environment

We maintain a "fragrance-free environment." In consideration of people with allergies and sensitivities, please refrain from wearing perfumes or scented products to services. Thank you.

Parking

If you are driving to Shir Hadash services at Plymouth Church:

1. We expect there will be reasonable street parking availability. The Milwaukee Parking Enforcement division has waived the Resident Parking Permit (RPP) requirement during our service times! Please be sure to park only on the RPP side of the street (*and not on the side with posted time restrictions*). **Look below for a map showing the RPP streets in the neighborhood.**

2. Disabled parking is available on the South side of East Hampshire in front of Plymouth Church. Please observe the No Parking restrictions on the North side of East Hampshire; Parking Enforcement will issue tickets if you park in No Parking zones.
